Jay McAuley, after a successful playing career at UGA and coaching career at the Division I Wofford College, is bringing his talents to Lassiter High School. Coach McAuley grew up in the Cobb County area and had a promising high school playing career at Pope. McAuley was named the 2022 Skip Prosser Man of the Year by College Insider Inc. McAuley was also featured in The Athletic's annual 40-under-40 publication, listed as No. 17 of the most 40 influential people in men's college basketball. Additionally, McAuley was named to ESPN's "40 Under 40" list, ranking the top 40 head coaches at the Division I level - with McAuley ranked No. 27.

To start the season, Coach McAuley and his team will take the court for a scrimmage against Denmark at home on November 8. The Trojans will begin their official season against North Springs at home on Tuesday, November 14.

May Prado won the United States Marine Corps UI7 Women's National Championship, qualifying her for a spot on the 2023 U.S. UI7 World Team. Prado represented the United States at the UI7 World Championships in Istanbul, Turkey over the summer. Prado is the first female wrestler from the state of Georgia to represent the country on the U.S. World Team. Prado will compete for Lassiter as a senior this year.
